# WONDERGLASS

by atelier oï

Séléné takes its name from the personification of the moon in the Greek tradition, and takes its shape from early scientific inquiry into planetary movement. An original glass form is cut in half, as though struck through by a pendulum's arc – the instrument used by Robert Hooke and Isaac Newton to prove orbital motion and universal gravitation. Dynamic lights which cast a cyclical array replicate this celestial dance, drawing attention to the hollow interior space of the collapsed material and thereby revealing gravity's sculptural work.


Cast glass
